

# **EVENT GUIDELINES**

Contestants - It is your responsibility to read, understand and abide by event rules and guidelines. Our rules and guidelines are in place to assure a smooth-running event for all to enjoy.

- Dress Code:
  - Jeans or appropriate long pants
  - Cowboy Boots. Must have boot heel.
  - Long sleeve shirt. Sleeves rolled down. Buttons/Collar are not required.
  - Hats/Helmets optional.
  - NO BALL CAPS/VISORS!
  - All fees must be paid at the show office PRIOR to making your run.
    - NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER ENTRY!
    - o 1X processing fee per rider applies to each contestant entered, unless otherwise stated in specific event details.
    - All entries are submitted online.
    - Payment is due at the time of entry submission.
    - \*\*\*Insufficient funds checks will be charged a \$25 service fee\*\*\*
    - Late entries accepted onsite.
    - o Deadlines and fees associated with late entry subject to specific event details.
- Pre Entry draw will be posted online no later than the Wednesday prior to the event at:
  - o <u>www.GoForBrokeProductions.com</u>
  - Pre-Entry spots may be sold.
  - Horse/Rider changes MUST be completed in the show office based on deadlines shown in specific event details. (NO EXCEPTIONS!)
  - Horses MUST be run in the position drawn.
  - Failure to do so will result in a disqualification.
  - Running out of turn in a manner that effects the other contestants in a drag will result in disqualification. It is your
    responsibility as a contestant to verify your draw and position with the gate official.
  - Any changes or corrections to the draw after online posting will be posted at show office and noted on the official's sheet.
  - It is your responsibility as a contestant to know the position of the horses drawn.
- You MUST CHECK IN with the gate official and be IN the holding pen/area (as defined by the gate official) when your drag is called for.
  - o It is your responsibility to check in with the gate official and be prepared to run in your drawn position.
  - Every effort will be made to give each contestant fair and ample time to enter the arena at the gate crew's discretion.
  - We do reserve the right to scratch a contestant for failing to begin there run after 3 gate calls or 3 minutes time has elapsed.
  - We do allow circling in the arena prior to your run, limited to 3 circles and subject to the 3-minute rule stated above.
  - Only one horse may be in the arena at any time during the competition.
  - o Drags occur ever 5 runners, regardless of scratches
  - Big drags occur every 50
- A horse may not be shown by more than one person in a class.
  - UNLESS they qualify under the immediate family rule.
    - "A horse may not be shown by more than one person in a class, unless the following conditions are met. Both contestants are members of the same immediate family <u>who reside in the same household</u> (husband, wife, children and grandchildren 21 & under). Neither contestant is showing any other horse in that class. In no case will the same horse be run MORE than twice in the same class."
    - At a show where sanctions require us to offer a separate class for Youth, Adult, Master and Senior classes, those "aged classes" will draw together as 1 class but be placed separately.
    - At a show that is a mandatory roll-over from the open to an aged class, you may enter any of the aged classes as an "agedonly" contestant. This will be designated at YO, AO, MO or SO and your run will be drawn WITH the rest of the open class (not run separately)
- Contestants will receive a no time for knocking over a barrel or breaking the pattern.
  - Contestants who are given a no-time for going off pattern or for a downed barrel may complete the pattern, but under NO CIRCUMSTANCES are they allowed to circle a barrel twice.
  - At the discretion of show announcer or gate official a rider may be asked to leave the arena immediately if they are taking excessive time to train or placing themselves or animal in a situation that is deemed unsafe.
  - A re-run may be granted at the show officials discretion based on the following circumstances:
    - Outside interference to the riders run (ie, dog running across the arena, loose horse inside the arena)

## A barrel was not placed on its marker correctly

- Rerun will be made on a fresh drag at the end of the class you are competing in
- Or on a fresh drag immediately following the set you were in (riders' choice).
- PRIOR PENALTIES WILL APPLY.
- o If rider chooses to run again any penalties made during re-run WILL apply to official time.
- Any penalties accrued during the re-run WILL apply to the official time.
- Show officials decisions are FINAL.

#### Side Pots

- Youth, Adults, Masters & Seniors pay out 4D format, ½ splits
  - Youth entries defined as 18 & Under as of the 1st day of the competition season for IBRA memberships
  - Youth entries are defined as 18 & under as of January 1st for NBHA sanctions
  - · Adult age is 19-39 and is determined based upon your age on the first day of the season for IBRA members.
  - Master age is 40 and over and is determined based upon your age on the first day of the season for IBRA members.
  - Senior age is defined as 50 & over as of the day of your birthday for NBHA.
- Futurity Side Pot will pay 2D (1 sec. splits, progressive payout)
  - Futurity age 5 & under as of November 15.
  - Under no circumstances will a horse be allowed to "futurity" more than 1 season.
  - Derby Side Pot will pay 2D (1/2 splits, progressive payout
    - Derby age is 5 7
    - A derby horse is defined as a horse that has completed 1 futurity season
    - A derby horse may have 2 or more "derby seasons" dependent on the age it was futuritied.
- POLE BENDING
  - 2D format, 2 second splits
  - 1 down pole = +5, 2 down poles is a no time
  - Progressive payout
- At a show where sanctions require us to offer a separate class for Youth, Adult, Master and Senior classes, those "aged classes" will draw together as 1 class but be placed separately.
- At a show that is a mandatory roll-over from the open to an aged class, you may enter any of the aged classes as an "agedonly" contestant. This will be designated at YO, AO, MO or SO and your run will be drawn WITH the rest of the open class (not run separately)
- A carry-over or roll-over time will be from the class proceeding. (Example a contestants 1<sup>st</sup> run of the day is in the futurity class, they elect to also RUN in the open but carry-over (roll-over) to the youth. The CO/RO time for youth class would be the time from the open.

#### Sanctions:

- We sanction with many associations for contestant benefit.
  - Examples of sanctioning bodies may include, BBR, WPRA, BRF, IBRA, BRF, PEWC
- As a contestant you are responsible for paying your memberships TO THE ASSOCIATION prior to competing.
- Results are turned into sanctioning associations within 10 days of event completion.
- It is YOUR responsibility to verify WITH the association that your points/money earned/qualifications are correctly accounted for.

#### Payout Guidelines for Open 5D

- A Completed W9 form is required to be on file before we can issue you any winnings from our events.
  - This is NOT optional (regardless of age or amount of money won) you are required to submit a completed W9 to the show office before we can issue your winnings to you.
  - Go For Broke OPEN 5D will be 1/2 second splits (ex. 15.0, 15.5, 16.0, 16.5, 17.0)
    - 51-100 entries pays minimum of 3 places per D
    - 101-143 entries pays minimum of 4 places per D
    - 144-200 entries pays minimum of 5 places per D
    - 201-250 entries pays minimum of 6 places per D
    - 251-333 entries pays minimum of 8 places per D
    - We may elect to pay additional places based at show management discretion.
      - If a "D" does not fill, we reserve the right to make adjustments to the payouts to allow fair and adequate disbursements of the jackpot.
      - 75% payback jackpot of entry fee
        - 100% advertised added money will be paid back



We (Go for Broke Productions) reserve the right to refuse entry for ANY reason. Behavior by contestants or spectators that is deemed inappropriate will not be tolerated and is grounds for dismissal from event.

# Futurity/Derby Guidelines (The Iowa Futurity/Derby & the Big J Futurity/Maturity)

- Open to Futurity horses 5 and under not entered in any barrel racing competitions prior to 11/15/2020
- The Big J Maturity (August event only) is Open to Derby/MATURITY (\*\*Maturity eligibility list available on website) any horses 7 years or younger that have previously entered the Big J Derby since its beginning in 2011. Please contact
  Lynde directly if you are questioning your eligibility for the Big J maturity.
- Any entrant found to be competing on a horse not meeting the above criteria will forfeit any money and prizes won and be disqualified from the event and any future Go For Broke Productions events.
- Futurity and Derby/Maturity will pay back 100% of advertised added money + 75% of entry fee
  - Stalls are NOT included in the cost of entry.
- 25% of the jackpot will be paid to EACH go round on a 2D Format 1 second splits for the FUTURITY
- 25% of the jackpot will be paid to EACH go round on a 2D Format ½ second splits for the DERBY
  - o 50% of the jackpot will be paid to the AVERAGE (Futurity & Derby)
  - Futurity & Derby/Maturity Average will be a STRAIGHT PAYBACK (No D's)
    - 1-15 entries will pay 4 places
    - 16-22 entries will pay 6 places
    - 23-35 entries will pay 8 places
    - 36-50 entries will pay 10 places
    - 51+ entries will pay 12 places
- \$25 late payment fee will be accessed to your entry if your total entry is not paid IN FULL by POST MARK DATE.
- LATE ENTER onsite until 8pm Friday of the event at the show office w/\$25 late fee (must have all paperwork including copy of papers) to late enter futurity/derby/maturity events.
- REFUNDS –a refund of a futurity or derby/maturity entry that is paid in full, will only be issued if accompanied by a veterinary statement of release. Refunds are issued less 25% of fees paid.
- An entry paid in full can be sold to another eligible contestant.
- Horse Subs allowed (for death or inability of horse to compete) w/vet affidavit and all appropriate paperwork.
- Rider MUST be declared at Horse Check In
- Rider Changes NOT allowed after the 1st horse runs in Fut/Der/Mat
- The same rider MUST compete on the horse in both go rounds.
  - Failure to abide by this rule will result in a disqualification and forfeit any monies won in Fut. /Der./Mat.
- Carry over to the open MUST be declared 1 hour prior to the start of the Futurity/Derby/Maturity classes
  - All Futurity & Derby/Maturity horses MUST be checked in w/COPY OF PAPERS (digital proof is acceptable)
    - Futurity & Derby/Maturity horses will be marked at check-in (no exceptions)
    - $\circ$  Check ins time/location TBA for each event.
- Futurity and Derby/Maturity DRAW will be a FULL Random draw (including late entries).
  - $\circ$  ~ Posted at the show office by 10pm ~ on Friday (weekend of the event) ~
- The second go round of the Futurity & Derby/Maturity will run in complete reverse order.
- Other than noted above, all standard Go For Broke Productions competition rules apply.
- A downed barrel will be a NO TIME for the GO ROUND and in the case of a carry over time to the Open 5D but will be issued a +5 for consideration in the OVERALL AVERAGE Payout. A horse going off pattern will be given a NO TIME

# FULL HOUSE INCENTIVE

(Formerly the Big 8 Performance Fund)

- Annual enrollment fee is \$225
- The FULL HOUSE INCENTIVE is open to ANY sire.
  - Anyone may pay a stallion into the FHI. If the stallion owner themselves doesn't pay the enrollment, they
    must mail or email us acknowledgement that someone else is paying the enrollment fees and that the person
    paying the fee will receive any breeders % winnings for that enrolled stallion during the calendar year.

## Payout FHI

- 100% of the annual enrollment fee (\$225) is returned to the events through payout (and awards) to progeny of enrolled sires and stallion owners.
- Added money at FHI events will be split between Futurity & Derby/Maturity Classes.
- 15% of the total paid enrollments will be paid out to the stallion owners
- Stallion owner % will be split equally between The Iowa Fut/Der and the Big J Fut/Mat events based on overall FHI side pot average results.
- Full House Incentive side pot entry fee for the The Iowa Fut/Der and the Big J Fut/Mat events is \$50.
- 90% jackpot of entry fees.
- FHI futurity/derby/maturity/open payouts will be based on a 2 run average, 2D format (progressive payout)
- Places to be paid back determined by entries and enrollments.
- Any unpaid monies (due to un-filled placings) will be split among those who placed at the discretion of GFB productions.
- Maturity horses (those 8 & older) competing at the August Big J Maturity are eligible for FHI breeder's payout if the stallion is currently enrolled and all entry fees are paid.
- OPEN Full House Incentive SIDE POTS
  - Open to any horse sired by a FHI sire regardless of age.
  - \$100 Added Money at every regular season GFB event for FHI horses
  - 25 Entry fee (90% of entry fee will be jackpotted)
  - $\circ$  2D format, 1 second split progressive payout.
